FROM THE DIRECTOR OF MISSIONS

In June of last year, Southern Baptist Convention (SBC) messengers called for an independent investigation into how matters of sexual abuse have been handled among leaders of the SBC. The Sexual Abuse Task Force and Guidepost Solutions released the report this past Sunday, May 22, 2022. While I am still carefully reading the findings and recommendations contained in this extensive report, the summary of findings is deeply troubling and heartbreaking.

First, my prayers are with all of those who have suffered deeply from these tragic actions of abuse and neglect. My heart is broken for all who have been hurt so badly by the actions of others in positions of trusted leadership. My prayer is that our response to these actions will be one of genuine repentance and loving restoration.

As I reviewed the report, I was saddened and grieved by many of the findings. The report provides details of alleged inappropriate behavior as well as inadequate response to reported cases of sexual abuse.

The report not only addresses serious issues that demand resolution, but also identifies specific recommendations that lead toward reform. Southern Baptist messengers will meet again in just a couple of weeks to respond to the findings and act upon the recommendations in this report. It is my prayer that the response will be prayerful and thoughtful, honoring to God and to all who have suffered from this abuse and neglect.

For the past several weeks, I have been inviting you to join with me in prayer for spiritual awakening. With broken hearts we need to cry out to God. Our hearts need to be tuned to God. I would like to invite you to come together for a time of prayer on Wednesday, June 8th at 10:00 am at the Knox County Association building. Please contact our office at info@kcab.org, or contact me personally, and let us know that you want to join in this urgent and united time of prayer.

Now, more than ever, it is time for us to know God's mission; be His Church; and *Live it Out!*

CONGOLESE PEOPLES

The Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) is the largest country in surface area in Sub-Saharan Africa, equaling the size of Western Europe. DRC has the third largest population of poor people globally. DRC is known as a 'Christian nation' with a little less than half of the people as Roman Catholic, and nearly half being Protestant. Less than 5% make up all other religions. There is a growing number of Congolese refugees settling in the USA. Estimates are 1,200 or more have arrived in Knoxville within the last 2+ years to join friends and family already settled here. Recently here in Knoxville our KCAB staff discovered that a small group of Congolese refugees had formed a church and were looking for a place to meet. We have since then met and helped them partner with one of our churches to share space for worship and ministry.

PRAYER REQUESTS

- Pray that Congolese believers will seek Him with all their heart and walk closely with Christ.
- Pray for healing of trauma that many refugees experienced as they fled their homes, lived years in refugee camps and are now trying to navigate and transition to life in America.
